

# Law Enforcement Screening Process



**Officer Places Person Under a Section**

**YES**

**Is Person intoxicated, injured, under the influence of drugs, or otherwise medically compromised?**

Advise that you have a person under section, that you are on route to TTBH, and are requesting a screening.

**Officer/Hospital contacts Crisis Hotline: 1-877-289-7199.**

**Officer transports person to nearest TTBH office.**

**TTBH case manager responds within 1 hour, and assess person. (Screening may be delayed depending on persons medical condition). Officer remains with person.**

**After person is screened by case manager, does person meet criteria for inhospitalization?**
